

## Facts about the camp

Dates: Arrival 26<sup>th</sup> / 27<sup>th</sup> of July, departure 9<sup>th</sup> / 10<sup>th</sup> of Augus

m / 10<sup>th</sup> of August

Participants: 6 girls and 6 boys, one from each country, age 16-18 years

Arrival/Departure: The participants will be met by Rotarians at the

Gardermoen airport, Oslo, or at the Oslo Central Station

Organization of the camp: First week is spent in the area around Oslo. Responsibility

of Skedsmokorset, Nesodden and Nittedal Rotary Clubs. Second week is spent in the Valdres valley. Responsibility of Valdres, Sør-Valdres and Øystre Slidre Rotary Clubs

Cost: Travel expenses to Norway, pocket money and insurance must be paid by the participants. The organizing clubs sponsor the cost of the whole stay and all activities

Accomodation: First week in host families, with the exception of a canoe trip where

accommodation will be in huts. Second week spent in huts at

a camp most of the time. Toilets and shower available

Insurance: The participants must be insured against illness, accidents and third party

damages. No insurance is provided by the camp

Language and food: English language and standard European/Norwegian food
