Hjelpemiddelfondet established 2002 by Marianne Irgens Hagen and Carlos Caballero a Norwegian ideal, unpolitical non-government organisation.

Main focus is collecting, and reuse of equipment for disable people, that is by various reasons no longer used in Norway. By today it's been shipped over 90 containers with; articles as wheels' chairs, hospital beds, ambulances and mechanical aid.

Donation 2016

Nesodden Rotaryklubb has received a donation of technical products no longer usable in the Norwegian market from Sunrise Medical. The variation of products is from new and unused manual wheelchairs, engine aided wheelchairs, tandem bicycles with/ without engines. Spare parts and stock from the Nordic markets.

Nesodden Rotary club has completed Global Grant #78926 together with Hjelpemiddelfondet, Norwegian Labour and Welfare Administration and rotary club of Juan Lacaze, the authorities in Uruguay.

Summer of 2016 – completed 6 container shipments from Norway, Sweden and Denmark. The goal of the Global Grant is to create technology centres with trained personnel like occupational therapists,

physiotherapists, technicians/engineers, etc. with expert knowledge about assistive device application and adaptability.

CENATT - The project is an initiative from Mides (Ministry of Social Affairs), with the support of the: Montevideo City Council, UTU (Uruguayan Polytechnic University) and Nesodden rotary club, Hjelpemiddelfondet (NGO - Norway). The project aim is to be nationwide in Uruguay.

The UTU (Uruguayan Polytechnic University) would help in the local manufacture of certain kind of technical aids.

This would be a qualitative improvement compared to other former experiences, since the theoretical training process and practice will be conducted in the same place.

Budget

Funding is planned to be within a Global Grant program with a minimum 30.000\$ the clubs of the district is asked to contribute, you may contribute by loading of shipments or as a financial partner. Today we have on-board club from Taiwan.
